In addition to being a clinical associate in the Department of Prosthodontics at the Faculty of Dentistry University of Toronto, **Dr. Leslie Laing** holds a position of Prosthodontist and Dry Mouth Specialist at Toronto Public Health Dental and Oral Care Clinics. She also has private practices in Toronto, Mississauga and Brockville devoted to implant and Prosthodontic dentistry. At each of these practices, she has established Sjögren's Syndrome/Dry Mouth Resource Centres and continues to conduct research projects on various aspects of Sjögren's and other causes of dry mouth. She was recently awarded the Queen's Toronto Alumni Branch Tricolour Champion (2020) and the Queen's University Alumni Association Humanitarian Award (2022). She is honoured to be the current President of the Sjögren's Society of Canada.

Dr. Marie Hudson is a rheumatologist and clinician-scientist at the Jewish General Hospital and Lady Davis Institute, and an Associate professor and Member of the Division of Experimental Medicine in the Department of Medicine at McGill University. She pursues research in systemic sclerosis and is a founding member of the Canadian Scleroderma Research Group. Her particular research interests include interstitial lung disease, muscle involvement and cellular therapies for scleroderma.
